Dear Sir,

I enclose a letter from the Levis Ferry Limited withdrawing the classification of their two winter ferry steamers "PLESSIS" and "COLOMB" as they state that the benefits derived do not warrant the expenses incurred. These vessels come under the annual inspection of the Canadian Government inspectors, which they consider sufficient and which is compulsory.

The summer ferry steamers "LEVIS" and "LAUZON" owned by the same company are not classed with any society.

The special survey No.2 on the "PLESSIS" and "COLOMB" were part held last year and has now been advanced on the former vessel by examination in drydock, examination of the tail shaft and effecting a small stem damage repair.
