May say that the easing gear has been fitted. I have issued Boiler Test Certificates and am forwarding numbers as requested.

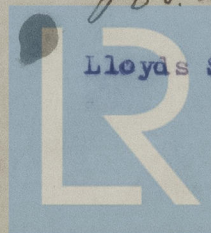
The Equipment of both vessels have been bought here and testing cables is unknown here, but they are furnished with 60 Fathoms of reliable 7/8 chain and one 3.3.13 anchor which they cannot use in winter work. The warps and lines are good manilla 90 Fathoms and 2 1/2 " diameter and all other gear first class. The numbers for boiler certificates issued to each vessel are PLESSIS No.1 COLOMB No.2 .
