Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th ultimo relative to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "ONDO", and to acquaint you that the matter has received careful consideration.

In reply I have to say that while the Committee have hitherto been pleased for the continuance of the class of this vessel to meet the wishes of your goodselves by accepting reports of survey held from time to time by your Mr. Hartenstein or his representative, they much regret that, in view of the importance of the Special Survey which is now due on the steamer, viz:-Special Survey No.3, they are unable to approve of this course.

I have accordingly to say that if you desire to maintain the classification of the steamer "ONDO" in the Society's Register Book, it will be necessary for the vessel to be brought to a port at which the Society has a Surveyor stationed, and perhaps you will kindly let me know what steps you propose taking in the matter.
