Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 24th December, respecting the Report on the Steel Screw K. "R.R.S.", I have to inform you that I have interviewed the Owners as requested, and they gave me to understand that they do not wish to have the full 100 A.class for this ship as a cargo vessel, also that they were not prepared to carry out any structural alterations, they arranged with the Board of Trade to grant them a load line as in the case of their S.S. "ENGLISH ROSE".

They also asked me in the event of their wanting to re-instate the vessel for fishing purposes, would they again have to put the vessel through survey, I informed that as the vessel was now employed as a cargo coasting vessel, I was under the impression that their class would be taken away.
