Gentlemen,

M I have to inform you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Society's Surveyors at Hull stating that the new steam trawler "R.R.S.", Messrs. Cochrane & Sons' No. 563 vessel, has left their port for Lowestoft, where her machinery will be placed on board.

To complete the survey on the hull the following remains to be done, viz:- the engine and boiler casings to be riveted up and caulked after the machinery has been fitted on board; masts, rigging and capstan to be fitted; small boat to be supplied; 60 fathoms 5½" hawser and 60 fathoms 4" warp to be supplied, and hand pumps to be tested.

I shall be glad if you will be so good as to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the survey forward a report on Form 8 for the information of the Committee with a view to the classification of the vessel.
