Nature of Survey

The class of this vessel is subject to the after peak being tested and found tight on the vessel's return to Savona, to some damage through heavy weather being repaired, and to the indented shelter deck sheerstrake, etc. being faired at the Owners' convenience.

The Genoa Surveyors now report that the after peak has been tested and found in order.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject as above, except as regards after peak.
