I beg to acquaint you that the General Committee of this Society had under their consideration yesterday your letters of the 7th and 8th ultimo, relative to the steamers "SAINT ANDRÉ", "SAINT JEAN", "SAINT JOSEPH", "SAINT LOUIS", "SAINT MARC" and "LA DIVES".

The Committee regret to note the decision at which you have arrived, to discontinue the classification with this Society of the steamers referred to, and in the circumstances they have given instructions for the classes of the "SAINT ANDRÉ", "SAINT JOSEPH", "SAINT MARC" and "LA DIVES" to be at once withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (. . .) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I am much obliged for your intimation that the steamers "SAINT JEAN" and "SAINT LOUIS", have not yet been finally transferred to your Company, and that you will advise me of the completion of the purchases in due course.
