

TRANSLATION OF A LETTER DATED, PARIS 8/1/16, RECEIVED FROM
CIE GLE TRANSATLANTIQUE.

We have informed you yesterday the 7th instant, that we desired to withdraw from the 1st January 1916, the classification in Lloyd's Register of the Steamers "SAINT ANDRÉ" "SAINT JEAN", "SAINT JOSEPH", "SAINT LOUIS" & "SAINT MARC" which we have bought from the Compagnie Navale de l'Océanie, and which are also classed with the Bureau Veritas.

On account of a special agreement between us and the Compagnie Navale de l'Océanie this company has the vessels "SAINT JEAN" and "SAINT LOUIS" still in hand, of which we will take over the "SAINT LOUIS" about the month of March and the "SAINT JEAN" about the month of June.

Our letter of yesterday ought therefore to be altered and it must be understood that the class of Lloyd's Register of steamers "SAINT JEAN" and "SAINT LOUIS" will only cease from these vessels have been taken over from this company, time of which we will inform you.

It must be understood that the class in your Register of the vessel "LA DIVES" as well as the vessels "SAINT ANDRÉ" "SAINT JOSEPH" and "SAINT MARC" will be withdrawn from the 1st January 1916.
