With reference to my First Entry Reports No. 666 and to your letter of the 20th inst. regarding the new S.S. Saint Joseph, I respectfully beg to inform you that the survey was completed yesterday afternoon at St. Nazaire.

The vessel has been examined in Dry Dock and the bottom found in order throughout.

The upper & weather decks and the waterway have been tested as required by the Rules, and the results of the tests were quite satisfactory.

The matter of the fees is also settled.

I have also issued a provisional certificate "F", and now enclose a copy of the same.

In compliance with the request contained in your letter of the 20th inst., I wired to you this morning as follows; - "Saint Joseph, survey complete".
