I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th inst enclosing one from Johannes Ick, withdrawing from the Society's Classification the steamers "DISKUS", "MUNDUS", "GLOBUS", "HELIUS", "MUNDUS", "OPUS", "ROBUS", "SOPHUS" and "TURNUS", which have been transferred to the Germanischer Lloyd survey, and have to acquaint you that attention is being given to this matter.
