Dear Sir,

E. I return herewith one copy of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 20th instant, of general pumping arrangement proposed for Messrs. Wm. Denny & Bros. Ltd., Yard No.1347, and I have to inform you that this plan will be approved provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon, and the remaining requirements of Sections 20 and 34 of the Rules (1938-9) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is noted that the deep tank overflows overboard and it is suggested that a more desirable arrangement would be to lead the overflow pipes through the bulkhead into the engine room bilge as shown in red on the plan, since it has been found that, in a number of vessels, cargo has been damaged by water passing the storm valves.

I shall be glad if you will kindly arrange for a plan of the pumping arrangement in the machinery space to be forwarded to this Office for consideration.

The plans sent for reference purposes are also enclosed.
