With reference to the London letter of the 21st ultimo and previous correspondence respecting the fitting of bilge suction for draining the flat situated above the deep tank, I beg to inform you that the Builders now propose to fit a combined scupper from the gutter round the oil fuel tank and the deep tank top, draining into a gutterway in engine room as shown on the enclosed sketch, and as approved in London letter of the 13th July last.

A copy of the approved pumping plan is in London.
