M. Reverting to your letter of the 11th instant regarding Messrs. Wm. Denny's Yard No. 1347, I beg to inform you that the proposal of the Admiralty, Merchant Shipbuilding Branch, as a war emergency measure, to dispense with the third bower anchor in vessels building or licensed to be built on their behalf, has been approved by the Committee on the understanding that if and when the ships engage in ordinary peaceful merchant pursuits the equipment will be made in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.
