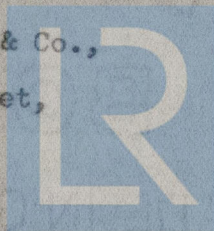
I am in receipt of your letter of the 13th instant regarding the length of chain cable proposed for Messrs. Wm. Denny & Bros' Yard No. 1347, and in reply I have to inform you that the length of chain cable required by Table 53 of the Society's Rules to be supplied for this vessel is 270 fathoms. The Committee has, however, agreed as a war emergency measure to accept in vessels of this size a length of cable of 225 fathoms, on the understanding that if and when the vessel is engaged in ordinary peaceful merchant pursuits, the length of the cable will be increased to 270 fathoms to comply with the tabular requirements.
