Yard No. 1347 - Plan of Boat Deck.

The contents of your letter of the 11th instant submitting the above plan have been carefully noted, and I have to direct your attention to Section 22, Clause 7 of the Rules which requires that deckhouses be of sufficient strength, and as explained by Dr. Webster to Mr. Cotton on the telephone, to comply with this requirement, having in view the length of the deckhouse, it is considered that the top of the house should be plated in accordance with my letter of the 8th instant and the plan has been amended accordingly.

At the same time I have to inform you that the scantlings and arrangements as shown and amended on the plan will be approved, provided they be carried out to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

One copy of the plan in question is enclosed herewith, and I shall be glad if you will kindly return the same to this Office after noting.

The remaining copy of the plan has been retained in this Office for record.
