Yard No. 1347 - Plan of Midship Deckhouse.

With reference to your letter of the 24th ultimo submitting the above plan, I have to inform you that the scantlings and arrangements as shown and amended thereon will be approved, provided they be carried out to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

At the same time I have to acquaint you that in view of the length of the deckhouse it is considered the boat deck should be plated for its full length outside the line of the engine casing. Plating should also be fitted in way of passenger accommodation. The plating where wood sheathed should not be less than 3/16" in thickness.

I shall be glad if you will arrange to submit the plan of the boat deck for approval.

One copy of the plan in question is enclosed herewith, and I shall be glad if you will kindly return the same to this Office after noting.

The remaining copy of the plan has been retained in this Office for record.
