With reference to your letter of the 24th ultimo regarding the proposal to fit solid round iron pillars between the second and upper decks, instead of tube pillars in the above vessel, I have to inform you that provided the pillars on frame 22 be increased to $4\frac{1}{8}$ " dia., on frame 54 to $4\frac{3}{4}$ " dia., frame 92 to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " dia., and on frame 145 to 5" dia., the proposal will be approved.

The arrangements at the heads and heels of the pillars should be to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.
