The undersigned having been called upon by Lloyds Agent on the demand of **J. Norberg,** the Master of the S.S. "Western Knight" I surveyed that vessel on the **2nd.** day of February, in consequence of her having put back to this port after stranding off Ras Kaau.

DISCLOSED SECTION.

No. 119

On examination of this vessel on the day named I found the Master stated he had stranded between Ras Kaau & Paraseval Rock about 3/5ths of a mile East of the latter place, which is 37 miles from this port. Vessel had gone easily ashore on a soft bottom at 11/20 p.m. on January 28th. After discharging about 440 tons cargo (wheat in bags) into S.S. "Veghileh" the vessel again floated & was assisted off by S.S. "Meyun" on February 1st at 1 a.m.

I recommended that a diver be sent down to examine hull & he reported that there was no apparent damage to hull, but that a wire rope was round tail end shaft between stern boss & propeller.

I recommended that this be removed & again visited vessel on 3rd. inst. & found from soundings taken on previous day vessel was not making any water.

I hereby recommend that vessel re-load the discharged cargo & proceed on her voyage remaining as classed in the Register Book, subject to docking for examination at first convenient opportunity.
