Dear Sir:-

Referring to your letter of the 7th inst. regarding our Report No.828 on the steamer "WESTERN KNIGHT" and the dia. of the M.P.Cylinder beg to state that the dia. 48" is correct.

The machinery of the Ames S.B & D&D Co. vessels No.11-12 & 13 "Western Ally", "Western Knight" and "Western Glen", See our Reports No. 791-828-850 respectively, are duplicates of each other with the exception of the M.P Cylinder of No.11 which is 46" instead of 48".

In the case of No.11,"Western Ally", a number of spongy places developed in the bore of the M.P.Cylinder after the work on it was well advanced to which I took exception although the cylinder casting was otherwise perfect.

To hasten the work on the engines and delivery of the vessel the Shipping Board representatives agreed to have a liner 1" thick fitted in the cylinder which was done and the dia. thereby reduced to 46"
