Survey held, &c. Examination under boilers, peak tanks, A.P. spaces, Nos. 4 (p & s) and 5 (s.s.) D.B. tanks and the testing of the A.P. & No. 4 D.B. tanks (2, 7 & 10-40).

Subject to permanent repairs (leakage) to shell plate in 2nd strake below sheer in way of A.P. tank (p.s.), to (holed) bunker saddleback and to indented shell plating (p.s.f) at the first opportunity, to the buckled W.T. floor at after end of No. 4 D.B. tank (s.s.), to cement box being removed and permanent repairs effected to buckled No. 4 plate in 3rd strake below sheer etc (s.s.) at the first convenient opportunity, to Upper Deck stringer plate in Bridge space (thin) being specially examined at the next dry docking, also to (15 fathoms of chain cable being supplied †).
