Replying to your letter of the 15th instant I have to acquaint you that, in accordance with the Society's Rules applicable at that time, this ship became due for 3rd Special Survey No.1 in August 1938, and in November of that year the Owner applied for the year of grace in which to carry out this inspection.

A General Examination was held by the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam in November 1938, and as a result the Committee agreed to the ship retaining her class on the understanding that the Special Survey would be carried out at the end of August 1939 when the year of grace was due to expire.


In March 1939 the Owner advised the Society's Surveyor at Piraeus that the ship had been classed with the Germanischer Lloyd, and in these circumstances the Committee gave instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Society's Register Book with a red line indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
