Your Register for 1941/2 gives under particulars of Classification for this vessel under character heading a red line expunging her entry with the date 5, 39, underneath, and in brackets re-classification contemplated. Your notes advise that a red line with date underneath indicates that the vessel's class has been expunged from the Register Book at the date specified because from non-compliance with the Society's Rules as regards surveys, the vessel was not entitled to retain her classification.

We would be very grateful if you could give us any information as to the circumstances attending the expunging of vessel's entry in May, 1939, in particular, in what respect the vessel did not comply with your Society's Rules.
