No.579 built by Messrs. Harland & Wolff Ltd., Belfast.

The material has been tested by the Surveyors  
to this Society. The scantlings are in accordance with the  
Rules for a working pressure of 356 lbs. per square inch.  
The Reservoirs were tested in the presence of the undersigned  
by hydraulic pressure to 712 lbs. per square inch, shewed no  
signs of weakness and were found sound and tight at that pressure.  
The working pressure should not exceed Three Hundred and  
Fifty-Six pounds per square inch.
