I duly received your letter of the 15th instant advising plans in connexion with Messrs. Aalberg Vaerft's Yard No.64, and have to acquaint you that with heavy oil engines for main propelling purposes, having particulars as stated in my letter of the 21st April last, the plan showing details of the stern tube will be approved, provided the whole of the work be carried out to your satisfaction.

It is noted that the after bush of the port stern tube will be lined with "Bakelite" and no objection will be taken to the proposal, provided the port screwshaft be drawn for examination of the "Bakelite" lining when the vessel has been in service for a period of one year. I may explain that at the expiry of this period the question of subsequent surveys taking place at the usual intervals prescribed by the Rules will be considered.

It is concluded that the "Bakelite" lining is being fitted at the Owners' request, but I shall be glad if you will state if this is so.

Two copies of the plan are being returned under separate cover.
