Dear Sir:

In reply to your letter of the 27th instant regarding the maintenance of class on the above vessel, I have this morning spoken to Mr. Boyle, the Owner's Representative, who states that the Special Survey or General Examination, will in all probability be carried out on the West Coast.

In this connection, Mr. Boyle points out that the vessel drydocked at the Sun Shipyard on the 14th of October last, at which time several shell plates were renewed, and numbers 8 and 9 cargo tanks were tested in way of these renewals, and at the same time the anchors and chain cables were ranged and the chain locker cleaned, examined and coated.

He requests that these items be credited to the Special Survey No. 2 which falls due this month, and in my opinion this request merits the favorable consideration of the Committee, and perhaps you will advise me regarding this in due course, so that I may pass the information on to the Owners.
