ASSESSMENT OF VALUE.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that we, A. S. BOWYER, and JOHN STEWART, undersigned Marine Surveyors and Valuators at this Port, did at the request of the Consul for Norway in Natal, Survey on the 3rd December, the Norwegian Steel S/S "HAMPHOLME" of Oslo, for the purpose of assessing her value as she now lies in the Prince of Wales Graving Dock in a damaged condition.

From Lloyd's Register of Shipping and Supplements, we find the "Hampholme" (ex "Thordis") No. 21552 in Register Book, 4480 ton steel screw steamer of 2615 tons register, 7100 D.W., built by Harland & Scott, Iron Works, Oakland, California, in 1917, to 100 A.1. Class. The Hull passed Special Survey No. 2 in 1925, and she was then fitted with new Triple Expansion and Forced Draught by the North Eastern Marine Engineering Co., Newcastle-on-Tyne.

After careful examination of the vessel we would assess her value as she now lies in the Graving Dock in her present damaged condition, at
