S. With reference to Greenock first entry report No.18323 on the steamer "LUCISTON", I shall be glad if you will be good enough to draw the attention of the Surveyors to Circular No.1431 and ascertain from them and let me know whether the watertight bulkheads and the tunnel have been tested as required by the Rules and whether the freeboard has been verified and cut in the vessel's sides. It is concluded that the thickness and spacing of the middle line bulkhead stiffeners are as approved, but I shall be glad to be advised on this point also.
