Caird & Rayner, Ltd., Commercial Road, London, attend at their Works on the 24th July 1937 for the purpose of witnessing tests carried out on one evaporator, capacity 30 tons per 24 hours, to the order of Messrs. Smith's Dock Co., Ltd., North Shields, and intended for the s.s. "THODE PAGELUND".

The cast iron casing was hydraulically tested to 40 lb./sq.in. and the coils to 360 lb./sq.in. and found to be, as far as could be seen, sound and free from defects.
