Nature of Survey

The Oslo Surveyors report this vessel placed on a floating dock, rudder lifted, 1 gudgeon rebushed and a few rivets dealt with.

A deep tank for oil fuel has been constructed in No.3 hold, and alterations to the thrust recess carried out in connection with the fitting of Bauer Wach exhaust turbine in accordance with approved plans.

The tonnage opening in the Shelter Deck, together with freeing ports in well and overboard scuppers, have been closed.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 5,35.
