I return herewith two copies of the plan, forwarded with Mr. Roli's letter of the 28th instant, shewing proposed alterations in connexion with a proposal to fit a Bauer Wach Exhaust Turbine in the M.S. "THODE FAGELUND", and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the arrangements be carried out as shewn and amended on the plan and to your satisfaction, they will be approved.

The sides of the bulkhead where the beams pass through should be made watertight to your satisfaction, and additional rivets fitted through the deck flange of the beam at bulkhead 62 so as to provide an equivalent to watertight pitch, or alternatively the deck flange of this beam may be electrically welded. Further, the beams on the lowest deck forming the crown of the recess should be reinforced under the pillars above to your satisfaction.

As desired, I have wired you to-day as per copy of translation herewith.

The remaining copy of the plan is being retained for reference.
