Dear Sir,

A. With reference to my letter of the 9th instant regarding the fees for the survey during construction of the Twin S.S. "TIEN KWANG", Messrs. Yarrow & Co's No.1497 vessel, I have to inform you that the account which was rendered to the Owners has been returned to this Office with an intimation that in this case the fees are for account of the Builders. The Owners have to-day been interviewed on the subject, and they state that this is not a similar case to the Sister Vessel "SHU KWANG", in which they undertook to pay the fees. In this case the contract with the Builders included payment of the Classification fees, and in these circumstances an account should be rendered to the Builders in the usual way.

I return herewith the certificates of test in respect of the boilers, which accompanied your letter of the 6th instant, in order that these may be handed over with the other Certificates when the fees have been paid.
