Mr Sir,

Referring to Hong Kong Report No. 6136 on the S. S. "WILHEBOET", I am forwarding under separate cover plans showing arrangement of shift of butts in shell, tank top, and deck fitting to join new fore end to old aft end.

These are all original butts and no new butts are being used, but I shall be glad to be informed by cable if additional compensation will be required at the junction of new and old material, i.e. at the junction of the new fore end to old aft end of the vessel, as I understand additional compensation has been paid in similar cases, but possibly in a much older ship.

This vessel is about ten years old and the after end, free from damage, is in excellent condition and in my opinion additional compensation at the junction should not be necessary in this case.
