In the Supplement No. 4 received this morning I notice you have in the Engine Maker's Name (Cell 13) "D. Rowan & Co Glasgow."

The Vessel was built at Stockton; was taken out of the Dock until completed, and the Propelling Machinery was put on board by Messrs Blair & Co, who gave me the usual return for the same and were assured for and paid the Port Charges. I enclose herewith so that their name should appear before the Collector on Tolls inserted.

It is possible that the Boilers were made by Rowan & Co but of this I have no knowledge. I do know that Blair & Co imported some during the period when the Ship was being fitted out, these coming from Scotland.

I trust this information may be of value to you.
