As it is provided in the Committee's circular letter dated the 16th March 1918, that in such cases, this Society will issue the Machinery Certificate with the notation L.M.C. with date in red, it is submitted that this vessel is now eligible for the record of L.M.C. 8,18.

The Middlesbrough Surveyors should be requested to furnish the required particulars of the engines and boilers for posting in the Register Book.
