Dear Sirs,

S. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th instant respecting the case of the motor vessel "HENRIK AMELN", which is to be ready for trial trip on the 18th instant, and note that the Owners, after this trial trip, have decided to lay the vessel up and in these circumstances desire that the dates of the Special Surveys may be reckoned from the date when she is placed in commission.

The matter has been under consideration today, and I have to say that provided an examination of the vessel be made in dry dock, in accordance with the requirements in the Rules (see paragraph 1, page 11) to meet the exigences of such cases as these and a satisfactory report be received, the Committee will be agreeable to the periodical surveys dating from 4, 8 and 12 years from the date of such examination.

You will be good enough to inform the Owners accordingly and let me know in due course when the vessel will be placed in dry dock for the examination in question.
