I have to confirm the cablegrams which have passed between us respecting the steamer "LORD STRATHCONA", as follow :-

"LORD STRATHCONA NOW NEWPORT PURCHASED BY DOMINION COAL COMPANY WHO REQUEST PERMISSION ALLOW STEAMER PROCEED BALLAST SYDNEY AND MAKE TRIPS MONTREAL UNTIL CLOSE NAVIGATION WITHOUT WAITING COMPLETE REPAIRS OWNERS GUARANTEEING DRYDOCK HALIFAX AND THOROUGHLY OVERHAUL COMPLETING SURVEY IMMEDIATELY THEREAFTER ADVISE"

"LORD STRATHCONA REGRET UNABLE AGREE PROPOSAL STOP COMMUNICATING FULLY YOUR AGENTS HERE"

In this connexion I may say that the Special Survey No. 2 became due so long ago as May 1923, and that the Committee consider that in order to the retention of the vessel's class in the Society's Register Book this survey should be completed and all necessary repairs carried out before the vessel proceeds to sea.

I have already communicated this decision to Messrs. Japp Hatch & Co., Ltd., your Agents in this city, and have also informed them that the repairs necessary
