Dear Sirs,

S. I duly received your letters of the 31st ultimo and 5th instant respecting the case of the steamer "LORD STRATHCONA", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that in addition to the items mentioned in your letter as being necessary to be carried out before the steamer proceeds to sea with cargo, some odd shell rivets on the port side require to be cut out and renewed, and the transverse framing in way of the damaged plating to be dealt with as may be found to be necessary.

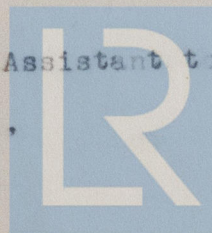
The remaining requirements of the Special Survey No.2 should also be carried out before she goes to sea, and as regards the ice damage referred to by you, this can be dealt with at the first convenient opportunity.
