(The class is subject to a bower anchor and 45 fathoms of chain cable being supplied).

The NEWCASTLE Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, and on account of damage through heavy weather a number of shell rivets in boiler room renewed and a fractured frame in engine room repaired.

On account of grounding no damage was found.

Shell plates F.12 & 13, G.13 and H.13 (p.s) found indented (cause unknown).

The riveting and caulking have been overhauled, and the Surveyors recommend permanent repairs at the first convenient opportunity.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 1.42, subject as recommended (and as above).
