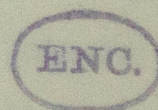

S.S. "WOLVERTON" AT ODESSA.

We confirm telephone conversation with you this morning, and now enclose copy of letter received from Mr. J. M. Cholson, the Master of this steamer, reporting on the damage sustained by his vessel through striking a submerged mine in the Black Sea on Tuesday 16th March last. As mentioned, we have a letter from the British Consul at Odessa which reads as follows :-

"Expect drydock about twenty fifth Think necessary
"advise Lloyds Agent supervise repairs Wire instructions"

It seems to us that a Surveyor appointed by your Corporation could be the proper man to supervise the repairs and we shall be glad if you will put us in a position to cable instructions to the British Consul.
