I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th instant, with enclosures, in connexion with the alterations proposed in the case of the s.s. "SUZY", the contents of which have been duly noted, and to confirm my telegram to you today as follows:-

"SUZY INCREASE OF ABOUT 59 INCHES IN DRAUGHT APPROVED PROVIDED BOTH WELLS FILLED IN CONVENTION REQUIREMENTS COMPLIED WITH DEEP WEB FRAME FITTED EACH HOLD WATERTIGHT BULKHEADS EXTENDED TO WEATHER DECK AND STIFFENING OF EXISTING BULKHEADS REINFORCED YOUR SATISFACTION THIRD BOWER ANCHOR REPLACED BY 29 CWT'S STOCKLESS ADDITIONAL 45 FATHOMS 1 8/16 GABLE SUPPLIED MINOR AMENDMENTS INDICATED ON PLANS COMPLIED WITH STOP IF WOOD SHEATHING ON POOP OMITTED BEAMS MUST BE FITTED EVERY FRAME OR STEEL DECK REINFORCED BY FORE AND AFT INTERCOSTAL GIRDERS YOUR SATISFACTION STOP IF AFTER WELL ONLY FILLED IN EQUIPMENT SCANTLINGS OF FRAMING AND FORWARD TOPSIDES SUITABLE AND INCREASE OF 6 INCHES IN DRAUGHT APPROVED STOP FORWARD PARTICULARS OF ALTERATIONS FORM RPT.8 AND C11CONTD".
