In reply to your letter of 15th instant regarding chain cable now supplied to this vessel, six lengths (not five) of cable ex S.S. "BOULDERPOOL" were examined, identification marks noted and placed on board S.S. "ROMANBY". A duplicate certificate has been supplied by the Cardiff Proving House as requested.

In the matter of suitable fee, the survey was confined to the inspection of chain cables, three visits were paid to the vessel in this connection and it is considered that a fee of £1.1.0 might be charged.


Our report 8 is being forwarded to Wokingham tonight.
