N.V. Wilton-Fyenoord Yard no. 669.

With reference to the plan of Werkspoor boilers nos. 2878/9/80 approved in your letter E. of the 6th instant, I have to-day forwarded to you under separate cover an amended plan of these boilers from which you will note that the tensile strength of the shell plates is now 44-50 kg/cm²,; consequently the thickness of the shell plating is now 31 mm. and the riveting of the longitudinal seams has been amended accordingly.

I may add that these alterations have been made at request of the Owners.

Will you kindly return one copy of the plan to this office when dealt with.
