With reference to your telegram and letter of the 19th January, 1940, regarding Wiltons 669, I proceeded to Amsterdam on the 24th January and joined Mr. Burgdorffer in the examination of the M.P. cylinder intended for this vessel.

I enclose a copy of a letter addressed to the Rotterdam Surveyors also a photograph of the M.P. cylinder side showing proposed cover fitted over porous defect cut out.

No trouble will be experienced and the method in dealing with the defect is entirely satisfactory.

Mr. Zantvoort, the Owners' Superintendent, is also now satisfied but he desired something in writing so I have asked Rotterdam Surveyors to hand a copy of my letter to him.
