The Ayrshire Dockyard Co., respecting the omission of the 'tween deck portion of the bulkhead in the fore part of No. 3 hold of their S.S. Nos. 445 & 446, and have to acquaint you that the case has received the consideration of the General Committee at their Meeting today.

With regard thereto I have to state that provided a deep web frame be fitted in the 'tween decks over the bulkhead in the after hold, the arrangement desired by the Owners will be approved, subject to a notation being made in the Register Book, as follows:-

"Tween dk. bulkhead in after hold dispensed with; 5 BH to Upper Deck, 1 BH to Second Deck only".

The plans sent for reference are returned herewith.


