The CARDIFF Surveyors report the vessel afloat and on account of damage through collision, some shell plating on the starboard side of Nos. 3 and 4 holds found indented and pierced and framing in way and bunker forward bulkhead buckled, the bulwarks etc. set in.


Temporary and partial repairs have been effected.

The Surveyors recommend the indented shell plating and framing starboard side of Nos. 3 and 4 holds and bunker bulkhead (s.s) be permanently repaired at the first convenient opportunity.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject as recommended.
