

With reference to Swansea Report No.22571 on the steamer "EMPIRE BUFFALO", I have to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Managers, requesting that the General Examination which will become due at the end of this month, (i.e. six months from the date of the survey held at Mobile in June last) may be postponed for the present. The Committee will be quite agreeable to accede to this request, provided you can state whether your examination of the vessel in October last was such as can enable you to recommend a fresh notation of "Examined 10,40" valid for six months from that date. I shall therefore be glad to hear from you on this point.
