Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 12th instant respecting the steamer "EGLANTINE", I have to acquaint you that this vessel was reported as being under survey for classification at Mobile on the 7th June but up to the present the reports of partial inspection held there for this purpose have not yet come to hand. They will, however, be forwarded for your guidance on receipt.

In the meantime, however, you should carry out the inspection of such parts as are opened up, but as a first entry survey will eventually be required as much as possible of this should be done.

The vessel will doubtless require a British Freeboard Certificate now, and in this connection you should forward full particulars on forms C 11 and c 11(comp) for freeboard assignment, together with any plans which may be available.
