I duly received your letter of the 25th October last having reference to New York Report No. 40285 of Partial Classification Survey on the Steamer "WEST CAWTHON", renamed "EMPIRE BISON", and in reply I may say that the Surveyors confirm that the scantlings of the frames, beams, stiffeners, etc. were verified generally with those shown on the plans; the thicknesses of the shell, deck and bulkhead plating were checked on edges but plating was not drilled at this time.

There were insufficient marks on the anchors and cables to permit of their being identified and the particulars of stream wire, towline, hawsers and warps were not obtainable on the occasion of this survey.
