With reference to the case of the steamer "EMPIRE BISON", I beg to acquaint you that the eventual fee for the survey for classification with this Society would have been £166.

Of this sum the following amounts are due for the surveys held at New York in July and at Manchester in August last, namely:- Hull £90, Machinery £20, Electric light £8, and I enclose an account to this effect.

In explanation of the delay which has occurred in forwarding this debit note, I may say it was intended to charge the fees due when the vessel next came under survey but it is now learned that she unfortunately became a war loss in November last.

A similar case is that of the steamer "EMPIRE MERLIN" in which the following fees are due for the work already done, viz:- Hull £25, Machinery £20, and I shall be obliged if you can see your way to pass this account for payment at the same time.
