Dear Sir,

S. Reverting to New York Report No.40285 of  
Partial Classification Survey held on the steamer  
"WEST CAWTHON", it is noted from the First Entry Report  
which has been forwarded, that the scantlings indicated  
thereon coincide generally with the particulars shown  
on the plan of midship section which has been forwarded,  
and it is concluded that the principal scantlings shown  
in the report have been taken from the plan and have  
not been verified, by drilling or otherwise, from the  
ship but I shall be obliged if you will kindly request  
the Surveyors to state if this is so, and in any future  
similar cases this point should be made clear so that  
there may be no dubiety as to the arrangements required  
to be made for the completion of the Survey.

S.S. With regard to the equipment now on board  
and the eventual assignment of the figure 1, no  
particulars as to the weight, test or origin have been  
furnished in the report and the Surveyors should state  
whether, as certificates were not available for the  
verification of the equipment, no markings were  
discernible or other evidence available in respect thereto.

It is concluded that particulars of the stream  
wire, towline, hawsers and warps were not ascertained  
in the course of the Survey at your port.
